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Clinton Lipscomb advises insurers in a broad range of coverage disputes and associated litigation, with a focus on first-party property damage claims and related issues including lost rents, lost revenues, and mandatory building upgrades. In the property claim context, he devotes much of his practice to advising public-entity insurers in coverage disputes with insured cities, counties, and municipalities. He has also advised insurers in automobile accident, product liability, and COVID-19 loss coverage cases.

The matters Clinton handles entail complicated factual considerations, unresolved legal questions, and major discrepancies in potential coverage amounts. Complex and novel issues permeate his representation of public-entity insurers in particular. Those disputes often fall outside the scope of the insurance code and involve situations not normally seen in private or commercial coverage, requiring both a deep working knowledge of the usual course of insurance claims and the creativity to devise solutions to problems with little or no legal precedent.

Clinton delves deeply into the facts of every case, filtering out the noise and catching details that are important but easily overlooked. This positions him to provide both objective assessments and uncompromising advocacy. Whether the dispute is early in the claims process or already in litigation, Clinton works closely with each client to tailor his advice to their goals, offering guidance and analysis that evolves with the dispute.

Clinton's prior experience performing investigative and compliance work at an international law firm gives him a leg up in the insurance world. He assisted with global anti-corruption investigations and advised clients facing formal regulatory and criminal inquiries by enforcement agencies. This set him up with a strong skill set to investigate claims and assess their associated risks in insurance coverage matters, where every case is unique. He understands the importance of nuance in written language and brings experience helping companies strengthen their policies and procedures to keep up with evolving regulations. In his prior practice, Clinton also advised on general corporate compliance and securities regulation matters and assisted with product liability litigation.
